The Phoenix Music Teachers Association's Piano Ensemble is one of the PMTA's oldest and most beloved traditions. Beginning in 1952, it continues to strive to provide a unique ensemble performance opportunity for piano students, using a variety of music genre.

Students must be 8 years of age by September 1, 2011 in order to participate in the 2012 Piano Ensemble. A Student Information Form is on the MWA website on the Events page.

Students attend three ensemble rehearsals that culminate in a dress rehearsal and a concert on Saturday, February 25. Rehearsals are on either a Tuesday, a Thursday or a Saturday during February. The rehearsals are either at Camelback High School at 4612 North 28th Street (East Side) or Arizona Conservatory of Arts and Academics at 2820 West Kelton Lane (West Side).

Duets are selected by the PMTA Ensemble Committee. Students are placed in the appropriate duet by their instructor.

Students are awarded trophies for participation in this event during the 4th, 8th and 10th years. Cash awards are made to students who have participated in this event for 9 and 10 years. Student photos are in the program every year after five years of participation. Adult students and Alumni may play in this annual event. The dedication and discipline evidenced by annual participation in events like the Piano Ensemble should be listed on college applications and job applications.
